# Know all men by these Presents,

That We, H. W. and H. E. Lincoln of Leeds, Androscoggin County, Maine,

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable considerations,

paid by The Central Securities Corporation of Augusta, Kennebec County, Maine

the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said Central Securities Corporation,

its Successors Heirs and Assigns forever,

A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Leeds, Androscoggin County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

Northerly by land now or formerly of Alton L. Thomas at highway; easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 1/2) feet easterly of the survey line now staked out across our lot, the Thomas lot and the Lothrop lot; southerly by land now or formerly of Ralph K. Lothrop and land now or formerly of Edwin Brown at highway; westerly by land of the town of Leeds known as the School House lot. Containing about seven and five-tenths (7.5) acres.
