CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Greene, Androscoggin County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width extending from my northerly to my southerly line and bounded northerly by land now or formerly of Edwin C. Rackley at the road; easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet easterly of a survey line now staked out across my lot, the Rackley lot and the Sturtevant lot; southerly by land now or formerly of Clara M. Sturtevant and land now or formerly of Myles R. Parker; westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet westerly of the survey line above described and by land of parties unknown. Containing about nineteen and one-tenth (19.1) acres.

Reserving to the grantor herein, an easement or right of way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to be located by the grantee in some location convenient for the said grantor and which will not, however, interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.

My title to the above property is derived as an heir of Adelbert J. Clark, and a deed from my brother William M. Johnson, dated January 26, 1917, recorded in the Androscoggin County Registry of Deeds, Book 263, Page 352; we being the sole surviving heirs at law of said Adelbert J. Clark. For prior reference see Book 14, Page 515.
