That I, GRACE L. CONANT, single, of Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

Its Successors Heirs and Assigns forever,

A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width extending from my northerly to my southerly line and bounded northerly by land now or formerly of Lizzie Foster at the highway; easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet easterly of the survey line now staked out across my lot, the Foster lot and the Willis Cole lot; southerly by said Willis Cole lot; westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$) feet westerly of the survey line above described. Containing about thirteen (13) acres.

Excepting from the above any rights which the Maine Central Railroad may have across this lot.

Reserving to the grantor herein, an easement or right of way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to be located by the grantee in some location convenient for the said grantor and which will not however, interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.

My title to the above property is derived by deed from William H. Conant dated September 21, 1921 and recorded in Androscoggin Registry, Book 352, Page 176.

Reserving also to the grantor herein the wood and lumber on said parcel, said wood and lumber to be removed by the grantor or written request of the grantees, or, if not removed by the grantor in season to avoid interference with construction or maintenance work, the grantees may cut and remove said wood and lumber at its option, the grantor herein to dispose on any slash caused by any of her operations on this lot in accordance with the state slash law,

To have and to hold the aforegranted and bargained premises,
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION, its successors

Heirs and Assigns, to its and their use and benefit
forever.

And I do further ^{Successors} with the said Grantee, its Heirs
and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises;
that they are free of all encumbrances;

that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said
Grantee to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my Heirs, shall
and will Warrant and Defend the same to the said Grantee, its Successors

Heirs and Assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands
of all persons.
