**Know all men by these Presents,**

Maine**

in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration

County, Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant,  
bargain, sell and convey, unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

Its Successors Heirs and Assigns forever,  
A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Livermore  
Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine, irregular in form and  
bounded and described as follows:

Northwesterly by land now or formerly of John Clark;  
easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half  
(62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet easterly of a survey line now staked out across  
my lot and the Clark lot; southeasterly by land now or  
formerly of Almon E. Wyman; southerly by land now or formerly  
of Ella O. Clark at the highway. Containing about one (1)  
acre.

My title to the above property is derived by deed from  
Mary M. Karn dated May 3, 1905 and recorded in Androscoggin  
Registry, Book 207, page 510.

Reserving to the grantor herein, the wood and lumber  
on said parcel, said wood and lumber to be removed by the  
grantor on written request of the grantees. Or, if not  
removed by the grantor in season to avoid interference with  
construction or maintenance work, the grantees may cut and  
remove said wood and lumber at its option. The grantor herein  
to dispose of any slash caused by any of his operations on this  
lot in accordance with the State Slash Law.

with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to the said

forever.

And I do stipulate with the said Grantee, its Successors  
and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises;  
that they are free of all incumbrances;

that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said  
Grantee to hold as aforesaid; and that I and MY Heirs, shall  
and will Warrant and Defend the same to the said Grantee, its Successors

Heirs and Assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands  
of all persons.
