A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Leeds, Androscoggin  
County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width extending  
from our northerly to our southerly line and bounded northerly by  
land now or formerly of Annie E. Pratt; easterly by a line parallel  
with and sixty-two and one-half (62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet easterly of a sur-  
vey line now staked out across this lot, the Pratt lot and the  
Rose lot; southerly by land now or formerly of Anna E. Rose;  
westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven  
and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet westerly of the survey line above des-  
cribed. Containing about seven and ninety-four hundredths (7.94)  
acres.
