A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Greene, Andros-  
coggin County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width extending from our northerly to our southerly line and bounded northerly by land now or formerly of Elsie E. Todd and land now or formerly of Charles S. Wight; easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half (62 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet easterly of a survey line now staked out across our lot, the Todd lot and the Hodgkins lot; southerly by land now or formerly of the Heirs of Will H. Hodgkins and land now or formerly of Edward A. Mower; westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet westerly of the survey line above described.
