Know all men by these Presents,

That I FRED I. MORRELL

of Greene, in the county of Androscoggin, and State of Maine,

in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration,

paid by the CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION, of Augusta, in the
county of Kennebec, and State of Maine,

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant,
bargain, sell and convey, unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

its successors HERBES and Assigns forever,

a certain lot or parcel of land, situated partly in Greene and
partly in Lewiston, all in the county of Androscoggin, being a
strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width extending from my
northerly line in Greene to my southerly line in Lewiston, bounded
NORTHERLY by land of Lester L. and Horace Fogg; EASTERLY by a
line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half ($62\frac{1}{2}$) feet easterly
of a survey line now staked out across this lot, the Lester Fogg et
al lot, and the George H. Knowles lot, and the land of the John M.
Jackson heirs; SOUTHERLY by land of George H. Knowles and land of
the John M. Jackson heirs; WESTERLY by a line parallel with and
three hundred thirty-seven and one-half ($337\frac{1}{2}$) feet westerly of the
survey line above described. Containing four and forty-four
one-hundredths (4.44) acres.

Being a part of the same premises conveyed to me by George V.
Poole, by deed of Warranty dated June 16, 1920, and recorded in the
Androscoggin County Registry of Deeds, Book 300, Page 136.

RESERVING to the grantee herein an easement or right of way
across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agri-
cultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to
be located by the grantee in some location convenient for the
said Grantor and which will not, however, interfere with the use
of the said above described parcel in connection with the trans-
mission of electric energy.

To have and to hold the aforesigned and bargained premises,
with all the privileges and appurtenances therof to the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION,

Heirs, and Assigns, to its and their use and behoof
forever.

And I do covenant with the said Grantee , its successors
and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises,
