Know all men by these Presents,

That I, Albra H. Taylor of Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, Maine,

in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration

paid by the CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION of Augusta, Kennebec County, Maine

the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION

and its Successors, Heirs and Assigns forever,
A certain lot or parcel of land in the town of Livermore Falls,
Androscoggin County, Maine, bounded and described as follows:

A strip of land four hundred (400) feet in width (except as noted), extending from my northerly to my southerly line and bounded northerly by land now or formerly of Elie O. Clark, easterly by a line parallel with and sixty-two and one-half ($62\frac{1}{2}$) feet easterly of a survey line now staked out across my lot, the Clark lot, land now or formerly of Lillian R. Cummings and land now or formerly of Charles I. Crosby, southerly by said Crosby lot, westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred thirty-seven and one-half ($337\frac{1}{2}$) feet westerly of the survey line above described. Containing about twenty-one (21) acres.

Excepting from the above any portion of the Lillian R. Cummings lot lying within the above described boundaries.

My title to the above property is derived by deed from Harry M. Sewell dated October 20, 1917 and recorded in Androscoggin Registry, Book 276, Page 325.

Reserving to the grantor herein, an easement or right of way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to be located by the grantee in some location convenient for the said grantor and which will not however, interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.

Reserving also to the grantor herein, the wood and lumber on said parcel, said wood and lumber to be removed by the grantor on written request of the grantee. Or, if not removed by the grantor in season to avoid interference with construction or maintenance work, the grantee may cut and remove said wood and lumber at its option. The grantor herein to dispose of any slash caused by any of his operations on this lot in accordance with the State Slash Law.

To have and to hold the aforegranted and bargained premises,
with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION, its Successors

and Assigns, to its and their use and behoof
forever.

And I do remanant with the said Grantee, its Successors
and Assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the premises,
that they are free of all incumbrances;

that I have good right to sell and convey the same to the said
Grantee to hold as aforesaid; and that I and my Heirs, shall
and will Warrant and Defend the same to the said Grantee its Successors

and Assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands
of all persons.
