the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY its successors - - - - - NOTE and assigns forever,

ACCO^TNT^Y OF PARCEL OF LAND

a small lot of land in the Town of Greene, Androscoggin County, Maine on the easterly side of land of the Central Maine Power Company near the State highway and bounded as follows: beginning on the easterly line of land of said Power company at land of Arthur R. Knowles; thence northerly on land of said Power company eleven hundred fifty feet to a point; thence southerly four hundred ten feet to a point one hundred thirty-two feet easterly of east line of said Power company's land; thence southwesterly about seven hundred eighty feet to land now or formerly of Arthur R. Knowles; thence westerly on said Knowles' lot seventy-five feet to point of beginning. Area of above lot of land about one and three-quarters acres.

RESERVING to the grantors herein, an easement or right of way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to be located by the grantee in some location convenient for the said grantors and which will not, however, interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.


