the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey, unto the said Central Maine Power Company its successors —— Maine and Assigns forever,

a small triangular lot of land in the Town of Greene, Androscoggin County, Maine on the easterly side of land ~~of~~ the Central Maine Power Company near the State Road and bounded as follows:—northerly by land of Walter W. Briggs, et al, for a distance of seventy-five feet; westerly by land of said Power company for a distance of about eight hundred sixty feet, easterly by a line extending from said Briggs lot southerly to a point on the easterly line of said Power company about eight hundred sixty feet southerly from said Briggs lot; said triangular lot of land being seventy-five feet in width at its northerly on land of said Briggs. Area of above lot of land about three quarters of an acre.

RESERVING to the grantors herein, an easement or right of way across the above described parcel of land for lumbering and agricultural purposes not to exceed twenty (20) feet in width and to be located by the grantees in some location convenient for the said grantors and which will not, however, interfere with the use of the said above described parcel in connection with the transmission of electric energy.
