A certain lot or parcel of land in the Town of Pownal, Cumberland  
County, Maine, triangular in form and bounded northerly by land  
now or formerly of William L. Sawyer and land now or formerly of  
Leon R. Carleton, et al; southeasterly by land now or formerly of  
Lewis L. Files; westerly by a line parallel with and three hundred  
thirty-seven and one-half (337 $\frac{1}{2}$ ) feet westerly of the survey line  
now staked out across our land and across the Sawyer lot and the  
Files lot. Containing about seven (7) acres.

The lot herein conveyed being a portion of the same property  
conveyed to us by deed from Francois D. Blackstone, dated April 6,  
1909 and recorded in Cumberland Registry, Book 839, Page 118.

Reserving to the grantor herein the wood and lumber on said
