the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said

CENTRAL SECURITIES CORPORATION,

and Assigns forever, a certain lot or parcel of land, with the buildings thereon, situated inLewiston in said County ofAndroscoggin , and bounded and described as follows:

Commencing on the westerly side of the County Road leading from the Clough Meeting House, so-called, to Lewiston, past the dwelling house now or formerly of Simon Carville, to the Northwesterly corner of land now or formerly in possession of William Clough; thence WESTERLY on line of said Clough lot about seventy-eight (78) rods to the end of a stone wall, to a large stone partly in the ground; thence NORTHERLY on or along said stone wall about twenty-four (24) rods to the Northerly end of said wall to a large stone marked "B"; thence NORTHEASTERLY on an air line sixty-two (62) rods to a stone bound of said county road; thence SOUTHERLY on said road forty (40) rods to the bound begun at.
