That MAINE YANKEE ATOMIC POWER COMPANY (hereinafter sometimes called the "Grantor"), a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine and having its principal place of business at Augusta, County of Kennebec, State of Maine, in consideration of one dollar and other valuable consideration paid by CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY (hereinafter sometimes called the "Grantee"), a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Maine and having its principal place of business at 9 Green Street in said Augusta, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns forever,

the perpetual right and casement to erect, construct, maintain, repair, rebuild, respace, replace, operate, patrol and remove electric transmission, distribution and communication lines consisting of suitable and sufficient poles and towers with sufficient foundations together with wires strung upon and extending between the same for the transmission of electric energy and intelligence, together with all necessary fixtures. anchors, guys, crossarms, and other electrical equipment and appurtenances, and to use, singly or in common with the Grantor, its successors and assigns, any transmission towers and wooden pole structures caused to be constructed by the Grantor, its successors or assigns, and suitable for carrying transmission lines over, along and across a strip of land of the Grantor located in the Town of Wiscasset, in the County of Lincoln, and

State of Maine, which land is more particularly located and described as follows:

Also conveying to the Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right and easement at any and all times to clear and keep clear said strip of all trees, timber and bushes growing on said strip by such means as the Grantee, its successors and assigns, may select.

The Grantor for itself and its successors and assigns, covenants and agrees with the Grantee, its successors and assigns, that it will not erect or maintain any building or other structure, or permit the erection or maintenance of any building or other structure, of any kind or nature upon the above-described strip, and will not place, permit or allow any material or growth of any kind or nature to accumulate on or be removed from said strip any or all of which, in the reasonable opinion of the Grantee, its successors and assigns, would endanger or interfere with the operation or maintenance of said line or lines constructed along and across said strip.

The Grantor further agrees that prior to May 1, 1972, it will obtain the release of the rights and interests herein conveyed from the lien of its First Mortgage Indenture to Old Colony Trust Company, Trustee, dated as of November 1, 1970, recorded among other places in the Lincoln County Registry of Deeds in Book 678, Page 1, and indentures supplemental thereto, under which Indenture The First National Bank of Boston is successor Trustee.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the aforegranted rights and easements, with all the privileges and appurtenances thereof to the said CENTRAL MAINE POWER COMPANY, its successors and assigns, to its and their use and beho forever. And it does covenant with the said Grantee, its successors and assigns, that it is lawfully seized in fee of the premises; that they are free of all incumbrances except the aforesaid First Mortgage Indenture;

that it has good right to sell and convey said rights and easements to the said Grantee to hold as aforesaid; and that it and
its successors and assigns, shall and will warrant and defend
the same to the said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever,
against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, except as
aforesaid.
