I am against the CMP Corridor for the following reasons:

1) the harm to maine outweighs the benefits. Maine will face all the harm and massachusetts will benefit. Should we become a part of massachusetts like we use to be?

2) The harm will be to our environment and our unique ability to provide wild and open spaces to those who crave such opportunities in the natural environment and rightly so.
