The Board of Directors of the Upper Enchanted Owners Road Association has voted on a resolution in opposition to the CMP New England Clean Energy Connect (NECEC) proposal. The Upper Enchanted Owners Road Association has 50 members, all of whom own land near Coburn Mountain where the proposed powerline will go. We feel that it would be a detriment to wildlife and native brook trout habitat, a visual detraction of undeveloped pristine contiguous wilderness, will negatively affect our property values and provides no benefit to Maine for electricity needs.
