

Standard Operating Procedures for Minimizing Fugitive Dust

Nordic Aquafarms is committed to maintaining clean and compliant construction and working areas that minimize conditions of ambient dust. It is everyone's responsibility to notify their direct manager if you see a condition causing fugitive dust.

Roadways & Work Areas

- Cleaning on and around all exterior areas such as roadways and loading/unloading areas is conducted on an ongoing basis.
- Consolidate and Cover outside material storage including any waste storage that may cause a condition of fugitive dust.
- All incoming and outgoing vehicles are visually inspected.

Manufacturing & Construction Activities

- Employees responsible for maintaining outside work areas will look to identify conditions of fugitive dust from any manufacturing/production and/or construction activities such as material handling, storage, processing, equipment malfunctions, and new construction activities. If a condition is identified that is causing a fugitive dust condition the plant manager will be notified immediately. The plant manager will deploy the necessary resources to mitigate the condition.

Employee Responsibilities and Training

- Employees responsible for maintaining outside work areas will look to identify conditions of fugitive dust from any manufacturing/production and/or construction activities such as material handling, storage, processing, equipment malfunctions, and new construction activities. If a condition is identified that is causing a fugitive dust condition the plant manager will be notified immediately. The plant manager will deploy the necessary resources to mitigate the condition.
- All employees will be trained upon hiring. Training will include:
 - Good housekeeping and preventative maintenance;
 - Materials management practices.
