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To whom it may concern:

I oppose the Advanced Clean Car II Program.

I have lived in Maine most of my life and know from experience and observation over my 70 years that Maine climate events are in flux across all seasons. I support actions that make sense for everyone to do their part to improve the environment. As an example in my neighborhood, residents plant native bushes around a lake shore to keep dangerous runoff out of the water. Citizens are changing behaviors to protect the environment in small and big ways when actions make sense for their own well-being. It takes time and education.
