I absolutely oppose this initiative, promulgated by group of unelected officials mandating thru the state such an unpopular, expensive and wholly unsuitable product (electric cars and trucks) upon a marketplace better shaped by consumer demand.

Electric cars are ill-suited for the characteristics of our geography in relation to its rural population, and in turn, Maine's climate. The recent power outage(s) to half of Maine residents during 18-22 Dec 2023 is an irrefutable example of why they are unsuitable. (Has the 98 Ice Storm been forgotten?) Further, required infrastructure (recharging stations) is at best nascent in our "larger" urban areas and non-existent elsewhere.
