The adoption of a clean sustainable energy solution for commercial vehicles is a multi-decade investment that needs coordinated public policy. As one of the largest commercial fleets registered in the State of Maine, Lucas Tree Experts, seems many challenges to the transition of an EV Fleet in the proposed time of the California Advanced Clean Truck Rules.

The state of Maine lacks the transmission infrastructure and power generating capacity to support this adoption at the proposed time frame, our State's large geographic footprint with a sparsely populated citizens has not invested in the critical infrastructure to support fleet EV charging and the cold weather of Maine creates significant technological challenges in the effectiveness of viable EV solutions compared to warmer climate locations as we sit here today.
