



Introduction

Maine Policy Institute submits this public comment to register our strong opposition to the adoption of the proposed Advanced Clean Car II (ACCII) and Advanced Clean Truck rules now under consideration by the Maine Board of Environmental Protection.

The ACCII and ACT programs are products of California's electric vehicle initiatives and are certified by the California Air Resources Board (CARB). The goal of these rules is to make Maine a primarily Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) state by 2032. If adopted, the ACCII's targeted mandates would require 43 percent of new car sales to be ZEVs by 2027 and 82 percent by 2032. California has implemented a ban on vehicles with internal combustion engines (ICE) and wants 100 percent of new vehicle sales to be ZEVs by 2035. The intent behind the implementation of these rules in Maine is to follow in California's footsteps and eventually ban the sale of ICE vehicles in the Pine Tree State.

There are several reasons why Maine Policy Institute is opposed to the adoption of these California-style mandates. Whether it's passenger vehicles or medium- and heavy-duty trucks, ZEVs are expensive to purchase, run, and maintain, and the mandates would strip consumers and businesses of the ability to choose for themselves what type of vehicle they want to drive. In addition, the infrastructure required to establish and maintain robust ZEV fleets for personal and economic use doesn't currently exist. Establishing an arbitrary timeline for the wholesale adoption of ZEVs and mandating their purchase before the market or existing infrastructure can accommodate them would be devastating for individual consumers, Maine businesses, and the supply chain.

ACC II Program

When compared to gas-powered vehicles, ZEVs are more expensive to purchase and maintain over the vehicle's lifetime. According to a 2021 study conducted by the Anderson Economic Group (AEG), a number of factors make ZEVs more expensive, including:¹

1. **Commercial and residential electric rates:** The average electricity rate in Maine is \$0.28/kWh,² making the cost of electricity nearly double the national average.³

2. **EV registration fees are more expensive:** As of 2018, the price to register a ZEV is \$250 due to efforts to make ZEV drivers pay their share of road repairs that are typically funded through gas taxes. The average cost to register a gas-powered passenger vehicle is \$35.⁴
3. **Cost of chargers and installation:** The average cost to install a charger at your residence is between \$1,200-\$2,500.⁵
4. **Deadhead miles:** Deadhead miles are miles driven searching for a charging station. According to the AEG, Maine has a total of 654 community chargers and 194 community DC speed chargers. By comparison, Maine has 1,373 gas stations.⁶
5. **Time Costs of Charging:** This refers to the time lost from finding a charging station, setting up the charger and then waiting the necessary time for charging to complete. By comparison, fueling an ICE vehicle takes just a few minutes.

If the ACCII mandates are approved, Maine people will be required to purchase a larger share of ZEVs over time, placing a massive burden on citizens that they are ill-equipped to bear. According to the 2022 U.S. Census, the median household income in Maine is \$63,182. Per capita income is \$36,171, with 11.5 percent of the population living in poverty.⁷ Maine citizens aren't in a financial position to take on the debt that's associated with mandated ZEV purchases.

A Kelley Blue Book report from July 2023 shows that the average cost of a new ZEV is \$53,469 and the average cost of a new gas-powered vehicle is \$48,334.⁸ In addition, the average cost of a used ZEV⁹ is significantly higher than its gas-powered counterpart.¹⁰ It's unreasonable and unrealistic to mandate that the average Mainer pay more than half of their annual income to purchase a ZEV, let alone the individuals who earn at or below the poverty level.

Even with the rebates and subsidies available, the cost of a ZEV is still financially out of reach for most Mainers. If an individual consumer qualified for the largest rebate — \$7,500

from Efficiency Maine — the cost still exceeds what the average Mainer can afford.¹¹ Requiring Mainers to purchase a vehicle outside of their financial means is government overreach and will inevitably result in indebting and impoverishing Maine families.

In order for Maine people and businesses to widely utilize ZEVs, there must be a robust infrastructure in place to accommodate all users. This infrastructure currently does not exist. As part of the federal government’s Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), \$7.5 billion was allocated to ZEV charging infrastructure.¹² With this limited funding and an expedited timeline to adopt ZEVs, the goal of this program is imprudent and unrealistic.

The federal government has a goal of 500,000 EVs on the road by 2030, and in order to achieve that goal, the U.S. would have to install 50,000 publicly available charging ports per year for eight years.¹³ The goal and reality don’t match up. In 2019, the Maine Legislature set a goal of 219,000 EVs on the road by 2030.¹⁴ Today, Maine sits at 9,500 EVs, four percent of the state's intended goal.¹⁵ While it is possible that massive federal and state investments in that infrastructure could partially alleviate that problem over time, the cost to taxpayers would be exorbitant, prohibitive, and put our state in a precarious financial position.

ACT Program

Infrastructure issues are directly related to the supply chain, and further disruptions to the supply chain would hurt Maine businesses and the consumers who rely on their goods and services. According to 2022 research conducted by the American Transportation Research Institute (ATRI), the projected cost of nationwide construction and overhaul of existing infrastructure to ZEV infrastructure is approximately \$35 billion, significantly more than the \$7.5 billion allocated by the federal government. The ATRI has also cited three critical challenges beyond cost as it relates to transitioning to an electric trucking fleet. These challenges include:¹⁶

1. Electricity supply: Electric trucks use more electricity and will need more stations, parking, and availability in rural and urban areas because of their diverse travel patterns across the country.

...Domestic long-haul trucking would use more than 10 percent of the electricity generated in the country today – while an all-electric U.S. vehicle fleet would use more than 40 percent. Some individual states would need to generate as much as 60 percent more electricity than is presently produced...¹⁷

2. ZEV production: There are currently about 12 million freight trucks that run on diesel or gasoline throughout the country. Producing enough ZEV trucks to transition the entire fleet will require substantial lithium battery production and the mining of raw materials. The bulk of these battery components are extracted elsewhere, increasing our dependency on foreign producers. Depending on the accessibility of cobalt, graphite, lithium, and nickel, the cost of ZEV production could increase over time.

“...ATRI’s analysis also quantified the tens of millions of tons of cobalt, graphite, lithium and nickel that will be needed to replace the existing U.S. vehicle fleet with battery electric vehicles (BEV), placing high demand on raw materials. Depending on the material, electrification of the U.S. vehicle fleet would require 6.3 to 34.9 years of current global production. This is the equivalent of 8.4 to 64.4 percent of global reserves for just the U.S. vehicle fleet...”¹⁸

3. Truck Charging Requirements: Due to the lack of charging stations, parking, and current electrification capabilities across the country, the volume of modifications necessary to accommodate a robust ZEV trucking fleet is a formidable challenge.

“...ATRI’s research demonstrates that vehicle electrification in the U.S. will be a daunting task that goes well beyond the trucking industry – utilities, truck parking facilities and the vehicle production supply chain are critical to addressing the challenges identified in this research.”¹⁹

Conclusion

Both the ACCII and ACT programs are impractical at this time and would have devastating economic effects for families, businesses, and our supply chain. The timelines associated with both of these programs go too far too fast without serious thought of the consequences. For these reasons, Maine Policy Institute strongly recommends against the adoption of the ACCII and ACT programs.
