

## Notice of Intent to Remove an Underground Oil Storage Tank Facility or Underground Product Piping

## INSTRUCTIONS

#### Maine law requires that notice be received by the Commissioner at least 10 days prior to the commencement of removal work.

The notice requirement applies to removal of an underground oil storage facility or components of an underground oil storage facility, and removal of underground piping at an aboveground oil storage facility.

The removal of an underground oil storage facility or underground product piping must be conducted in accordance with the *Rules for Underground Oil Storage Facilities*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 691.

**Who Must Notify?** The obligation to notify rests with the facility owner or operator. If the owner or operator is unknown, the owner of the property where the facility or tank is located must provide the removal notice.

**Who Must Be Notified?** Send the completed "*Notice of Intent to Remove an Underground Oil Storage Tank Facility or Underground Product Piping*" form (attached) to:

- 1. The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP),
- 2. The local fire department,
- 3. The Certified Underground Oil Storage Tank Installer named in this notice (if required see below), and
- 4. The site assessor named in this notice (if required see below).

If you need to reschedule the removal or abandonment to a later date after filing the notice, please call DEP Tank Registration staff at (207) 287-7688 (Augusta); or call the Department's regional Division of Response Services: Portland, (207) 822-6300; Augusta, (207) 287-7688; Bangor, (207) 941-4570; or Presque Isle, (207) 764-0477.

The Department may waive the 10-day notice due to exceptional circumstances. A written waiver may be issued only at the discretion of the applicable regional office of the Division of Response Services.

**Certified Underground Oil Storage Tank Installer Requirement:** If the facility was used to store gasoline, aviation fuel or other Class 1 liquids (liquids having a flash point below 100° F) within the last 12 months, the work must be supervised by a Maine Certified Underground Oil Storage Tank Installer <sup>1</sup>. **Site Assessment Requirement:** Site assessments must be conducted in accordance with 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 691, Appendix P for all types of facilities or a portion thereof, <u>except</u><sup>2</sup>:

- onsite consumptive use heating oil facilities (other than heavy oil facilities oil that must be heated during storage), and
- farm and residential motor fuel tanks of 1,100 gallons or less capacity and where the product is used only by the tank owner or operator.

The results of the assessment must be provided to the DEP within 45 days of removal of the tanks and piping. The removed tank or piping is not "properly abandoned or removed" until the site assessment has been submitted.

**Removal Confirmation:** Identify each tank removed: tank number, product and size. If only part of a facility is removed, clearly identify what was removed.

After the tank or piping is removed, please complete the "*Removal Confirmation Notice*" (attached) and send it to the Department.

**Replacement of Facilities:** If you intend to install a replacement facility that may be located in a wellhead protection zone or over a significant sand and gravel aquifer, you must register the replacement tank(s) within 30 days of removing the old facility, and commence installation of the new tank(s) within two years. See 38 M.R.S. § 1393(2)(B)(1) and *Rules for Siting of Oil Storage Facilities*, 06-096 C.M.R. ch. 692.

**Who Must Sign This Form?** This form must be signed by the facility owner or authorized employee of the owner.

### **Other Requirements:**

All underground oil storage tanks, whether in use or not, even if they are to be removed, must be registered with the Department by the owner or operator. If the tank or product piping is not registered, contact the Department for a registration form. This also applies to facilities that have aboveground motor fuel tanks with underground product piping.<sup>3</sup>

Do not use this form if a tank and/or piping is to be permanently abandoned by filling in place. If you believe that a tank and/or piping cannot be removed, contact the Tanks Registration Staff for a "*Request for Determination of Abandonment in Place*" form. In general, however, if a tank and/or product piping can be excavated, they **must** be removed.<sup>4</sup>

State law prohibits dumping tank contents on the ground. In general, residues from a gasoline tank constitute hazardous waste and must be transported and disposed of by a licensed hazardous waste transporter.
