  - Evidence of title, right or interest (TRI).
  - Copies of the published Notice of Intent to File and a list of abutters to whom notice was provided.
  - For corporations, a *Certificate of Good Standing* or a statement signed by a corporate officer affirming that the corporation is in good standing.

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO FILE MAINE WASTE DISCHARGE GENERAL PERMIT FOR ANTIFOULING PAINT CONTAMINATED WASH WATER

Please take note that, pursuant to the Maine Department of Environmental Protection General Permit for Antifouling Paint Contaminated Wash Water, MEG1700000, (applicant) plans to file a Notice of Intent for coverage with the Department of of (address) Environmental Protection (Department). Comments should be limited to the applicant's ability to comply with the terms and conditions of the General Permit. The Department will take these comments into consideration in determining whether to approve of the Notice of Intent.
