Submission of this Notice of Termination (NOT) constitutes notice that the entity identified in Section C is no longer in business, changed ownership, no longer engaged in Industrial Activity, does not have a regulated discharge of stormwater, or has filed a Notice of Intent or a No Exposure Certification to comply with Maine’s Multi-Sector General Permit. All required information on this form must be completed.

Section A: Permit Information

Enter the existing **MEPDES** Multi-Sector General Permit or No Exposure Certification number assigned to the facility identified in Section C. If you do not know the permit number call or write to your regional Industrial Stormwater Inspector (listed above).

Indicate the reason for submitting this **Notice of Termination** by clicking only one of the following buttons:

1. There has been a change in the listed owner/operator overseeing the facility or site identified in Section C. Include the date the change occurred.
2. Business operations have ceased, or the business has closed. Include the date of closure.
3. Title, Right or Interest in the facility has changed.
4. A change in operations has occurred that results in exposure of industrial activity or raw material to stormwater. The facility has filed a Notice of Intent to comply with Maine's Multi-Sector General Permit.
5. A change in facility operations such that industrial activity or raw materials are no longer exposed to stormwater. The facility has filed a No Exposure Certification.
6. The facility has filed an Individual/Alternative Permit for stormwater discharge associated with an industrial activity.
7. There has been a change in facility operational practices that eliminates all Industrial Activity, as defined in 06-096 CMR 521 (9)(b)(14). or the DEP Industrial Stormwater Inspector has determined that activity at the facility does not meet the definition of Industrial Activity, as defined in 06-096 CMR 521 (9)(b)(14).
8. The Department has determined the facility does not discharge stormwater to waters of the State or to a Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System.

Section B: Facility Owner or Operator Information

- The full legal name of the person, partnership, co-partnership, firm, company, corporation, association, trust, estate, governmental entity or other legal entity that owns/operates the facility or site. This may be the given name of an individual (as listed on their social security card) or a registered legal entity (please see number #2 in this section).
- Include the permit number assigned by the Department on the Approval of General Permit Coverage order.
- The mailing address of the identified facility operator where US Mail is regularly delivered. All correspondence regarding the permit will be sent to this address, not the facility address in Section C.
- The telephone number listed for the facility operator must be a number at which calls are regularly received during business hours (8:00 AM to 5:00 PM).

Section C: Facility/Site Information

- List the name of the facility or site, as it is commonly or locally known, which may be different from the information provided in Section B.
- The street address must be consistent with the e911 address assigned to the location. If no e911 address exists, a geographic description (e.g., intersection of Routes 9 and 55), city/town, and zip code must be used. Rural Route (R.R.) or P.O. Box addresses are not acceptable in this section.

Section D: Certification

An individual certifying as the responsible official must:

- For a corporation - a corporate officer with authority to bind the company; or
- For a partnership or sole proprietorship - a general partner or the proprietor; or
- For a municipal, State, Federal, or other public facility - a principal executive or ranking elected official
