

Service line inventory Public Notice Requirements under the Lead and Copper Rule Revisions (LCRR)

START HERE

What materials are present in the inventory?

Inventory contains only non-lead service lines

Inventory contains lead, unknowns or galvanized requiring replacement service lines

May use a written statement, instead of distributing inventory, declaring that the distribution system has no lead lines, galvanized requiring replacement lines, or unknown lines. The statement must include a general description of the applicable sources used to make this determination.

(Non-Lead PN template) 1 time posting for 1 year

Community systems:
Instructions to access inventory or written statement must be available in the CCR.

***Water systems serving greater than 50,000 persons must make the publicly accessible inventory available online.**

Non-transient non-community systems:
Notice or statement may be provided via the posting in public places, media, or through to all consumers via mail or email.

Non-transient non-community systems:
Notice may be provided via the posting in public places, media, or through to all consumers via mail.

Public Notice Required

Inventory must be made publicly available

Must inform all persons served by the water system at the service connection with a lead, galvanized requiring replacement, or lead status unknown service line.

Updated annually until all lead and GRR is replaced and all unknowns identified

Community system:

Instructions to access inventory must be available in the CCR.

Must provide direct delivery of public notice to each service connection using one or more of the following methods: hand delivery, electronic mail, automatic telephone dialing systems, or another form of direct delivery approved in writing by MEDWP.
