# **Called to Order:**

## **General Administration:**

<u>Approval of the May 19, 2011 minutes</u>, Teresa Trott motioned to accept the minutes with corrections. Kerry Smart 2<sup>nd</sup>. Board approves. Passed

<u>Financial Report</u>: Board would like a more detailed financial report for the next meeting. The board would like detailed indirect costs on the report. The Board would also like to estimate travel expenses for Board members Please assure accurate dates on the budget drafts.

We are seeing fewer operators taking paper exams. Fewer paper exams lead to less income for the Board.

<u>System Update:</u> There are 35 systems that need operators. Systems will be getting notices by the end of the week. There are a lot of operators calling in that are looking for classes in order to have their inactive license reinstated.

# Operators Update:

<u>Annual Reports:</u> Annual reports are done and go directly to the EPA. If the EPA approves, we keep 2% of our SRF.

Renewals: Last year we had fewer operators renew than the previous year. Renewals will be going out on the first of November.

<u>TCH</u>: TCH for each individual operator can now be viewed online and is usually updated on the website after entering each time a group sends in a bunch of training attendances.

<u>ABC</u>: October will be the last time for using the Direct Entry exam. ABC no longer supports the direct entry exams. ABC endorses sequential exams and warns Maine Board about reciprocity with states that require sequential.

- Several States only license an individual by what he or she does.
- 22 States require sequential.
- 33 States do not require sequential
- 15 states use AMP
- 30 States only use paper
- 2 States only use computer
- 33 States use both
