## NOTICE: To All Maine Retail Tobacco Licensees Date Issued: April 11, 2022

Effective immediately, the Maine CDC Health Inspection Program (HIP) is extending license periods for eligible Retail Tobacco Licensees. This one-time license extension authorizes the eligible licensee to continue sales of tobacco and/or tobacco products and is valid for 120 days from the date of this notice or until the licensee's renewal application is processed, whichever comes first. To be eligible, the licensee must have either submitted a Retail Tobacco License Renewal Application along with the required licensing renewal fee <u>or</u> renewed their license online.

A licensee must satisfy licensing criteria for this license extension to be valid and, by displaying this signed notice, is attesting to compliance with license requirements (10-144 CMR Chapter 203 - Rules Relating to the Sale and Delivery of Tobacco Products in Maine (the Rule)). State inspectors may require the licensee to produce a copy of the renewal application.
