Subject: Product Registration, Infiltrator Quick5 Standard and Quick5 Equalizer 36 Leaching Chambers

Dear Mr. Bachelder:

The Division of Environmental Health has completed a review of a registration application for the subject products. This information was submitted pursuant to Section 7HH of the 2023 Maine State Plumbing Code, Subsurface Wastewater Disposal Rules (Rules), for use of the products in Maine.

The Quick5 Standard and Quick5 Equalizer leaching chambers consist of plastic leaching chambers which are dimensionally similar to the Quick4 Standard and Quick4 Equalizer 36 plastic leaching chambers respectively, with the exception that they are five feet in length rather than four feet in length. According to the information you provided, the Quick5 Standard is rated by the manufacturer at 5.8 and 7 square feet per linear foot in cluster and trench configurations respectively, and the Quick5 Equalizer 36 chamber is rated by the manufacturer at 3.7 and 5.2 square foot per linear foot respectively in cluster and trench configurations.

On the basis of the information submitted, the Division has determined that the Quick5 Standard and Quick5 Equalizer 36 are acceptable for use in the State of Maine, provided that they are installed, operated, and maintained in conformance with the manufacturer's directions.

Because installation and owner maintenance have a significant effect on the working order of onsite sewage disposal systems, including their components, the Division makes no representation or guarantee as to the efficiency and/or operation of these Quick5 model leaching chambers. Further, registration of this product for use in the State of Maine does not represent Division preference or recommendation for this product over similar or competing products.
