Dear Mr. Bachelder:

The Division of Environmental Health has completed a review of a registration application for the subject products. This information was submitted pursuant to Section 6.HH of the Subsurface Wastewater Disposal Rules for registration for use in Maine.

The Infiltrator IM-540 tank consists of an injection molded two piece polyethylene and polypropylene septic tank of 540 gallons capacity. The seam between the upper and lower halves is sealed with an elastomeric gasket. The IM-540 tank has a 552 gallon effective capacity when used as a single-compartment pump tank and 475 gallon effective capacity as a single-compartment septic tank. A riser is available specifically for IM series tanks.

On the basis of the information, the Division has determined that the Infiltrator IM-540 tank is acceptable for use in the State of Maine, provided that it is installed, operated, and maintained in conformance with the manufacturer's directions.

Because installation and owner maintenance has a significant effect on the working order of onsite sewage disposal systems, including their components, the Division makes no representation or guarantee as to the efficiency and/or operation of Infiltrator IM-540 tank. Further, registration of this product for use in the State of Maine does not represent Division preference or recommendation for this product over similar or competing products.

The Division of Environmental Health has completed a review of a registration application for the subject products. This information was submitted pursuant to Section 6.HH of the Subsurface Wastewater Disposal Rules for registration for use in Maine.

The Infiltrator IM-1530 tank consists of an injection molded two piece polyethylene and polypropylene septic tank. The seam between the upper and lower halves is sealed with an elastomeric gasket. The IM-1530 tank has a 1,765 gallon effective capacity when used as a single-compartment pump tank and 1,509 gallon effective capacity as a single-compartment septic tank. A riser is available specifically for IM series tanks.

On the basis of the information submitted the Division has determined that the Infiltrator IM-1530 tank is acceptable for use in the State of Maine, provided that it is installed, operated, and maintained in conformance with the manufacturer's directions.
