Fact


There is currently no evidence that COVID-19 vaccines cause fertility problems in women or men.

Getting COVID-19 during pregnancy is not that bad, it will just be a cold.




Fact

COVID-19 can make you very sick during pregnancy. If you have COVID-19 during pregnancy, you are at increased risk of complications that can affect your pregnancy and developing baby.

The COVID-19 vaccine causes COVID-19 and will make you sick.



Fact

None of the COVID-19 vaccines contain live virus. They cannot make anyone sick with COVID-19.

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding, COVID-19 vaccination builds antibodies that can transfer to and help protect your baby.

Getting a COVID-19 vaccine can protect you and others around you from getting very sick from COVID-19. Keeping you healthy during pregnancy is important for the health of your baby.
