

Where can I get tested for COVID-19 in Maine?


I have symptoms that could be COVID-19.

- Call your healthcare provider to discuss options.
- Your provider will direct you to a COVID-19 testing site if recommended.
- If you do not have or cannot easily connect with a healthcare provider, please go to any state-sponsored testing site for free.
- If your symptoms get worse, seek care at an urgent care clinic or hospital emergency department.



I do not have symptoms, but I traveled or am a close contact to a person with COVID-19.

- Call your healthcare provider to discuss options.
- If they are unable to test you, please go to a state-sponsored testing site for free.
- Please call ahead to verify that the testing site can test individuals who do not have symptoms.



I do not fit either of these categories. Should I get tested?

- Maine CDC does not recommend testing for asymptomatic individuals who are not close contacts or did not recently travel.
