



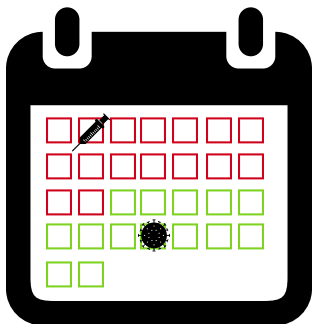
Quarantine Guidance for Vaccinated Close Contacts

What Does it Mean to be Fully Vaccinated?

People are fully vaccinated when they are more than 14 days past their final dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

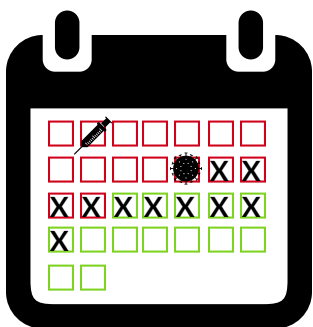
Exposure to COVID-19 Case After Vaccination

I am fully vaccinated and I was exposed to someone with COVID-19. What do I need to do?

Monitor for symptoms. Get a COVID-19 test 3-5 days after exposure. Wear a mask in indoor public settings for 14 days or until you receive a negative test result.



I am 14 days or less past my final dose of COVID-19 vaccine and I was exposed to someone with COVID-19. What do I need to do?

Quarantine for 10 days from your last exposure and monitor for symptoms. You should get tested immediately upon finding out and 5-7 days following your exposure. **You cannot test out of quarantine.**



I am fully vaccinated and I was exposed to someone with COVID-19. I am **now symptomatic**. What do I need to do?

Contact a healthcare provider to be evaluated for testing. Stay home while you wait for test results.
