



Characteristics:

Infection Rate by Age Group



- Most infections occur during the summer months, peaking in July
- 3% of patients were hospitalized
- 37 People with Lyme were co-infected with anaplasmosis
- 12 People with Lyme were co-infected with babesiosis

Symptoms Reported:



- EM (Bullseye Rash) 48%
- Arthritis 29%
- Neurologic 11%
- Cardiac 0.5%




60% of patients were male
