1. How do you think you'll use this material with your youth groups at home?
 - a. Additional Prompts: Challenges? How can you help each other?

2. How could you use the information or materials from this workshop to help your local fair to reduce risk of zoonotic disease?

3. How do you think chickens or pigs may become infected with influenza? What can you do to reduce their risk?

4. What do you think a sick pig looks like? Draw a picture of a healthy pig and a picture of a sick pig. What are the symptoms of a sick pig?

5. Should sick animals be allowed to show at the fair? Why or why not? And what can you do to prevent illness?

6. What are some ways you think you (personally, or your youth ag group) could prevent disease transmission at the fair?

7. Think about your barn at the fair and think through your process of bringing your animals to the fair, having your animals at the fair, and then bringing them home. What activities can you do to keep your animals healthy as well as other animals and people at the fair?

8. What should you do if your animals gets sick before the fair? During the fair?

9. What should you do with animals upon their return from the fair?
