

# Maine STD Diagnoses, January 1 to December 31, 2015

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Between January 1 and December 31, 3994 cases of chlamydia were reported to the Maine CDC. Total chlamydia reports received during 2015 represent a 13% increase compared to reports received in 2014 (3531). Forty-one percent (41%) of newly diagnosed chlamydia cases were among the 20-24 year age group. The rate of cases reported among females was over two times the rate among males. As compared to 2014, the number of gonorrhea cases increased by 78% (423 cases in 2015 vs. 237 cases in 2014). The majority of gonorrhea cases (54%) occurred among the 20-29 year age group. Thirty-six percent (36%) of gonorrhea diagnoses occurred in Western Maine District, and thirty-five percent (35%) of gonorrhea diagnoses occurred in Cumberland District. Demographic characteristics of Maine's 2015 chlamydia and gonorrhea diagnoses are presented in the table below.

Fifty (50) cases of early syphilis (primary, secondary, and early latent) were reported to the Maine CDC during 2015. This represents an increase of twenty-nine (29) cases compared to 2014 (21 cases reported). Eighty-two percent (82%) of the early syphilis diagnoses reported were male (41 cases) and half of the cases (50%) were diagnosed in people age 40 and older. Fifty-two percent (52%) of the early syphilis diagnoses occurred in Cumberland District and 24% in the Central Maine District. Thirty-six (36) of the early syphilis cases reported in 2015 were diagnosed as primary or secondary syphilis, while fourteen (14) cases were diagnosed as early latent.
