The Maine Immunization Program (MIP) is pleased to announce that the Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for children 6 months through 4 years and Moderna COVID-19 vaccine for children 6 months through 5 years is now available for enrolled MIP Providers to order through ImmPact today, Friday, June 3, 2022. This document will instruct you on how to order the vaccines.

Please be advised that although the vaccine is available to order, it cannot be administered until it has received final authorization from the Advisory Committee for Immunization Practices (ACIP).

In order for your facility to be eligible to place a vaccine order, please ensure that the following are up-to-date and complete:

- COVID-19 Vaccine Provider Agreement
- Current ImmPact User Agreement
- Current reconciliation of inventory

## Ordering vaccine in ImmPact:

The minimum ordering quantity will be 100 doses for each vaccine presentation, with a maximum order quantity of 300 doses per presentation.

Orders placed during Wave 1 (June 3 and 7) may arrive as early as June 20. Providers who have placed orders by June 7 at 3:00 pm may receive their order by June 20. Providers must be available to accept their shipment during this week.

Orders placed during Wave 2 (June 9 and 14) will arrive during the week of June 20. Providers should plan to be available throughout the week to accept their shipment upon arrival.

## **Creating a vaccine order:**

Under the 'Inventory' section on the side menu in ImmPact:

- Select "Pandemic Vaccine Request" by clicking on the link
- Choose the pediatric COVID-19 vaccine presentation and enter the dose amount that you would like to receive
- After creating your order, click "Submit Order"
