# TIMELINE FOR PFIZER/MODERNA COVID-19 VACCINE FOR CHILDREN UNDER 5 YEARS OLD

### June 14:

 Vaccines and Related Biological Products Advisory Committee (VRBPAC) will discuss Moderna COVID-19 vaccine for children under 6 years

#### June 15:

VRBPAC will discuss Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine for children under 5 years

#### Between June 16 and June 18:

The Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) will meet

# PREORDERING CADENCE

## June 3 through June 8:

Wave 1 will begin ordering

## June 9 through June 14:

Wave 2 will begin ordering

#### June 20:

- Orders from Wave 1 will arrive
- The Juneteenth holiday is observed on Monday, June 20
- Please make sure you are available to receive shipment at your facility

## **Beyond June 20:**

- Orders from Wave 2 will arrive
- Regular ordering schedule will begin after Wave 2

<sup>\*</sup>Providers should not administer vaccines until after ACIP's approval.

# **Ordering Updates:**

- Moderna and Pfizer will come in cartons of 10 vials each (100 doses total)
- Minimum order quantity will be 100 doses
- Each vial contains 10 doses
- Each carton contains 100 doses
