Did you know?

- The vast majority of parents fully vaccinate their child!
- Children can get shots to protect them from 14 serious diseases before age 2.
- The Minnesota Vaccines for Children (MnVFC) program provides free or low-cost shots to children 18 years of age and younger who do not have insurance or whose insurance does not cover the cost of vaccines.
