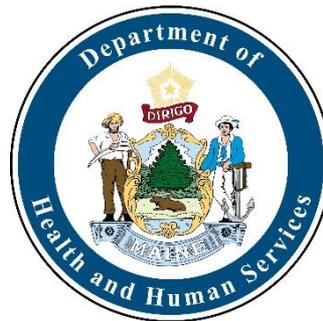



# Allocations

- Allocations released on Tuesdays
  - Orders need to be submitted by Thursdays
    - Monday/Tuesday delivery
  - Orders submitted on Friday
    - would be delivered Wednesday or Thursday

# Remainder of Phase Ia



## 1. Acute care (Weeks 1-4)

- Personnel who provide direct inpatient care (ED, ICU, COVID units)
- Non-hospital (EMS)
- Home health

## 2. Patient Facing/Infx Material (Weeks 4-6)

- Care for highest-risk patients (cancer, dialysis).
- Work with aerosols (dental)
- Prolonged-contact HCPs (PC)
- BH, CHW, optometry, school nurses, etc.
- Environmental services at each practice

## 3. Non-patient facing (Week 6+)

- IT, finance, management, medical records, etc.
