We completed an upgrade to our IIS registry last week. One of the new functions is the addition of fields to enter min/max temperatures daily. While we have requested that providers do this in the past, many have not been aware of the need because there was no place to enter this information in ImmPact. Now that this is necessary in ImmPact to reconcile your temperatures, many of you have questions on how to obtain this information from your data loggers. Attached is a quick guide to the data loggers from Control Solutions with instructions for the min/max temperatures on page four.
