Overview

The following report describes those who were consulted during the 2018 Community Engagement process for the Maine Shared Community Health Needs Assessment (Maine Shared CHNA). The first section includes a summary of each county's community events and numbers reached. These tables are then followed by a listing of organizations consulted in that process.

The last section is a summary of effort for the Key Informant Interviews (KIIs). KIIs were performed in order to ensure our process included input from Maine's vulnerable populations. The results from these interviews are woven into the analysis for each county's Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) reports and can be considered when listing those consulted in the CHNA process.
