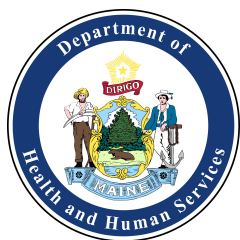

Participating Health Care Provider:**

- Breast Exams
- Pap Tests
- Pelvic Exams (internal exams)
- Mammograms (breast x-ray)
- Limited Diagnostic or Follow-up Services

Uninsured women undergoing treatment for breast or cervical cancer may qualify for MaineCare. Please call for more information.

## You May Get Free Services if:

1. You are a Maine woman, age 40\* or older, and
2. You have no health insurance, or your health insurance does not cover mammograms or Pap tests or you have a high deductible, and
3. You meet income guidelines at or below 250% of the Federal Poverty Level

*\* Limited openings for women age 35-39 who have seen a doctor and need additional tests for a possible breast or cervical cancer OR if they have not had a Pap in 5 or more years.*
