## Maine Newborn Bloodspot Screening Program

## **NEWBORN BLOODSPOT SCREENING REFUSAL**

I/We understand that Maine law requires all infants to be tested for 33 conditions that can cause menta retardation and other health problems. Included in this testing are cystic fibrosis, phenylketonuria hypothyroidism, galactosemia, homocystinuria, MCAD, and maple syrup urine disease. These conditions are easily detected and can be treated to prevent mental retardation and other health problems, which mainclude problems with growth, breathing problems, eye problems, blood clots, coma or death.  I/We understand that all infants must be tested except when a parent has a religious objection to the testing This objection relates to religious beliefs and is not an alternative to testing prior to early discharge.  I/We refuse to have my baby tested because my religious beliefs do not allow it. I have read this information and understand the possible consequences of this decision. I also understand that the MAINE NEWBORI SCREENING PROGRAM will be notified of this refusal, as is required by Maine law.  SIGNATURE:
