- You can purchase more than the face value of the farmers' market benefit(s) by using the Cash Value Benefit (CVB) if available.
- If the total exceeds the sum of the farmers' market benefit the additional charge will be deducted from your available CVB balance automatically by the point of sales system.
- You can use another form of payment if the total is more than your WIC benefits.

How do I use my farmers' market benefits?

- It is all digital!
- Download the BNFT App or go to www.mybnft.com and create an account
- Use the barcode in the BNFT App or print your barcode from www.mybnft.com and use it at the market or farm stand

What can I buy with the farmers' market benefits?

- Fresh, unprepared, Maine grown fruits and vegetables
- You can also use your fruit and vegetable benefits (CVB) at the market and farm stands using the BNFT App bar code

What am I not allowed to buy with the farmers' market benefits?

- You cannot buy honey, maple syrup, cider, nuts, seeds, eggs, cheese, meat, seafood, prepared items, fruits and veggies NOT Maine grown, and dried herbs.

Farmers' Market and Farm Stand hours may vary due to the seasonal nature of farming. Check out their Facebook pages for more information.

October 31st, 2022 is the last day to use your Farmers' Market benefits!
