Where can I use my farmers' market benefits?

Participating farms listed in this brochure accept WIC farmers' market benefits via the BNFT App. You can also locate local farms using the WIC Shopper app!

How do I use my farmers' BNFT App?

Download the BNFT app on you mobile device or tablet, link your WIC account, choose whatever Maine fresh fruit or produce you'd like, select

purchase, show the farmer the bar code, and that's it!

What can I buy with the FMNP BNFT App?

Any Maine-grown fruit or vegetable.

What am I not allowed to buy with the FMNP BNFT App?

Plants, seedlings, flowers, meat, eggs, cheese, bread, jam, jelly or processed foods and anything not grown in Maine.

What about using SNAP or EBT benefits?

Participant may purchase more than the face value of the eFMNP benefit(s) by using the Cash Value Benefit, if available.

If the total exceeds the sum of the eFMNP benefit the additional charge will be deducted from the participant's available CVB balance automatically by the point of sales system.

Participants shall use another form of tender if the sum of the transition exceeds the total of the participant's eFMNP and CVB benefits.
