

Who is eligible for FMNP checks?

- Children Four months -5 years old:
 - Four (4) checks for a total of \$20
- Pregnant women:
 - Four (4) checks for a total of \$20
- Breastfeeding women:
 - Four (4) checks for a total of \$20
 - A Breastfeeding woman is eligible for FMNP checks if she is receiving other WIC food benefits.
 - Fully and Partially Breastfeeding women are eligible for Farmers Market checks up to one (1) year post-partum
 - **Some Breastfeeding** women are eligible for Farmers Market checks **up to six (6) months post-partum**


Documenting FM Checks Issued Use Breastfeeding Item Issuance Screens



Local Agency Staff document Farmer's Market checks provided to participants

- Click on Participant Activities menu
- Click Breastfeeding in the drop down menu
- Click Issue Breastfeeding Items

Documenting FM Checks Issued




Issue Breastfeeding Items window

- Click Add
- Select Farmer's Market Preprinted Check for current season: Season
 Breastfeeding Supplies
 - from drop down item menu
- Type first FM check number issued to the individual participant in the ID field

•	Please note: this process must be repeated for each eligible participant in the household.		


Signing for FM Checks



Capture Electronic Signature window will open


- LA staff: click Capture Electronic Signature
- Explain to participant that they are signing for receipt of FM checks

Signing for FM Checks



Participant will see this statement on the signature pad before signing for the FM checks—note that the item they are signing for includes the wording "Farmers Market Preprinted Check Current Season"

Signing for FM Checks



Save signature as you would for WIC certification and benefit issuance

If no signature is captured, you cannot issue checks


What if...

 ...LA staff member's signature pad is not connected or not working?

Choose **Cancel** in the **Capture Electronic Signature window**

Plug a functioning signature pad into computer and proceed with capturing the electronic signature


How do the remainder of issued FM checks get assigned?



End of Day processing auto-assigns subsequent checks


- End of Day processing will assign the remaining subsequent check range based on participant category
 - Children will be assigned a check range of 4 checks
 - Pregnant and Breastfeeding women will be assigned a check range of 4 checks

End of Day processing auto-assigns subsequent checks



- Example: Child M Test (child participant) was issued 182004 today at WIC appointment
- After **End of Day** processing, this child will have check number 182005 assigned.


After End of Day Processing




After End of Day processing:

- Full check range issued will be in the participant record
- To access the assigned check range:
 - Click Participant Activities
 - Click Breastfeeding
 - Click Item Issuance History

Full check range issuance documented in BF Item Issuance History




End of Day processing auto-assigns subsequent checks



After **End of Day** processing, **Woman FMNP** will have check numbers 200111, 200112, and 200113 auto-assigned.

Full check range issuance documented in BF Item Issuance History




What if...

 ...LA staff member makes a mistake entering the correct number of the first FM check issued?

BF Item Issuance History—Error Correction



- Staff member entered 200150 in error for Minnie Mouse, a pregnant woman and called SPIRIT Help Desk prior to End of Day
- SPIRIT Help Desk gave directions on "return" of 200150 prior to End of Day processing
- Staff member enters correct first FM check issued, 200100
- End of Day processing assigns range of four checks, 200100-200102
- 200150 displays as "returned" and is available to be issued to another participant

What if...

 ...LA staff member provide a client with two check numbers that are not sequential?

Staff member may enter the non-sequential FM check number(s) actually issued in SPIRIT.

Non-sequential checks issued

- Example: Staff member issues check number 12341 and 12343 for a child participant
- Staff member enters FM check number 12341 in SPIRIT
- Non-sequential FM check number issuance is discovered
- Staff member may enter non-sequential FM check number 12343 which was actually provided to participant
- FM check 12342 and 12344 may be provided to the next child participant

Commonly Seen Errors

 Staff do not enter the lowest FM check number in SPIRIT. When End-of-Day Processing auto-assigns the remaining number of checks, the wrong check number is assigned

Child Jones is given checks 100102 and 100103.
 Staff enters check number 100103 in SPIRIT. End-Of-Day processing will attempt to assign check number 100104. Check number 100102 does not get assigned to Child.

- Staff document the check numbers in the wrong folder
 - Smith Household contains a Child and a Pregnant Mom.
 Family receives six (6) checks, numbers 100120 100125 (2 for Child, 4 for Mom).
 - Staff enters check number 100120 in Child's record and check number 100124 in Mom's record. End-Of-Day processing will assign check number 100121 to Child and attempt to assign check numbers 100125 – 100127 to Mom.
 - Check numbers 100122 and 100123 are not assigned to either Mom or Child, though they were provided to the family for use.

Staff document the check numbers in an ineligible client's record

 Household contains Infant and Breastfeeding woman. BF Woman receives checks 100150 – 100153

Staff enter check number 100150 in Infant's record

- SPIRIT is programed for Children to receive 2 checks and Pregnant and Breastfeeding women to receive 4 checks. Errors occur when staff only provides 2 checks to women.
 - Staff may not reduce the amount a participant category receives or place a maximum per household.
 - If checks are provided to a household, all eligible household members must be provided checks.
 - Staff may not choose to only issue to some eligible household members.
 - Household contains two children and a pregnant woman.
 Each child must receive \$20 and the mother must receive \$20. Household total is \$60.
