Mid Coast Hospital has a federal mental health training grant, CHA & Lincoln are applying for a grant. MHAT grants offer Mental Health trainings to lay folks to identify and connect to resources and improve environments (eg Sources of Strength, Mental Health First Aid) Also, Melissa learned that there may be state funding for Source of Strength, maybe NAMI?
