## **Syphilis in Women**

- Syphilis in women is increasing in Maine.
- If a person has syphilis while pregnant, it can lead to serious health issues, including miscarriage, stillbirth, low birth weight, or newborn death.
- Good News! Syphilis can be treated with antibiotics.

## If you are Pregnant

- Prenatal care is essential to keep you and your pregnancy healthy.
- You should be tested for syphilis at your first



prenatal visit or at least once during your pregnancy.

• If you have multiple sexual partners, a new sexual partner, or you or your partner(s) have an STI, you should be retested during your third trimester and at delivery.
