

Mosquito Anatomy Puzzles

Directions

This activity is intended for grades 3-8.

Split class up into four groups and have each group put the mosquito puzzle together. Then, have the students label the designated corresponding mosquito anatomy. There will be some labels that won't be used.

The goal of the game is to be the team that completes the puzzle and correctly labels the corresponding anatomy the fastest. Refer to the key for correct placement of labels.

Discussion can include the function of each part with emphasis on the proboscis and how only the female uses it to pierce the skin.
