These are the shots your teen needs – Immunize as soon as possible!

Age	Vaccine
Ages 11 – 18	Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis)
	Protects against tetanus, serious breathing problems, and whooping cough
	HPV (Human Papillomavirus)
	Protects against cervical cancer
	Heb A (Hepatitis A)
	Protects against hepatitis A, a liver disease
	MCV4 (Meningococcal)
	Protects against meningitis
	HepB (Hepatitis B)
	Protects against hepatitis B, a liver disease
	Influenza (Flu)
	Protects against serious respiratory disease.

- This is a routine schedule. Some teens may need additional shots.
- Please speak with your health care provider to see if your teen needs additional shots.
- Influenza recommendations change frequently; please contact your healthcare provider to see if your teen needs influenza vaccine.
