SL.3⁷⁰ Were people who injected drugs

Received an unlicensed tattoo prior to infection

Contact Investigations:



 31% of patients were hospitalized



Were incarcerated prior to infection



7.7%

Were people with multiple sex partners



Were people who used non-injection drugs



Were born between 1945-1965

- 97% of patients had symptoms
 - **97%** of patients had elevated liver enzyme lab results
 - 44% of patients had jaundice

Prevention:

- Do not share syringes or injection kit equipment
- Get tested for hepatitis C, especially if you are a person who injects drugs, were ever incarcerated, were born between 1945-1965, or received an unlicensed tattoo
- If you have hepatitis C, seek medical care
- Get vaccinated against hepatitis B, especially if you have hepatitis C
